### Recap of the 2004-2005 Season

Nomination of New Chairperson

Two co-chairpersons may be more effective in running MMSC racing. May decrease the stress of performing tasks.

Could divide up the race responsibilities between the two chairpersons.

Chairperson 1: responsible for all races at Sunburst, Holy Hill and Alpine Valley.

Chairperson 2: responsible for all races at Little Switzerland, Marquette and Cascade.

Tim Nettessheim has expressed an interest in being a co-chairperson. Todd Pfander would also be interested in being a co-chairperson.

Jim Robinson made a motion to have a tri-chairpersons for the 2005-2006 race season. Brad Butzke seconded.

Motion carried.

The three chairpersons for the 2005-2006 season will be Todd Pfander, Bob Fuge and Tim Nettesheim with Jim Fisher as an alternate.

## **Treasurer Information**

The treasurer should not have to "chase the money" for temporary and replacement bibs at each of our races. Beginning next season, there should be envelopes that hold the money and waivers or temporary and replacement bibs for each race. The envelope could have a sheet attached. The envelope is then given to the treasurer after the race, or to a chairperson if the treasurer is not present.
